



Case Management

- o Priority to Disabled and Age Dependent
- o Completed in 2 years on/about 30 SEPT 2018
- o Individuals with Access and Functional needs
- o 35% male 65% Female
- o 29% above age 65
- o 71 % No Income
- o Helps Prioritize



- o 90% of applicants have a Repair/Rebuild
 - "Unmet Need"
